



Summary of Quality projects/programs

Samaritan Advantage Health Plans – Medicare

Medicare Advantage Chronic Care Improvement Program: hypertension — increasing the number of members who have their hypertension (high blood pressure) under control.

Special Needs Plan Chronic Care Improvement Program: substance use disorder — increasing the percentage of Special Needs Plan members with newly identified substance use disorder who engage in treatment that is initiated in a timely manner.

InterCommunity Health Network Coordinated Care Organization – Medicaid

Performance Improvement Project: addressing high-risk pregnancies to reduce pre-term births — decreasing the rate of preterm births each measurement year.

Performance Improvement Project: reducing inequities in diabetes care — increasing medical and oral health utilization among members with Type 2 diabetes with a focus on members who reside in rural locations.

Statewide Performance Improvement Project: mental health service access monitoring — increasing the percentage of members with an identified mental health need receiving an outpatient mental health service.

Statewide Performance Improvement Project: initiation, engagement and treatment of alcohol and other drug use disorders — increase the percentage of members who initiate and receive substance use disorder treatment.
